## Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you to all parents of current SEN children who responded and shared their views on the SEND survey. It is wonderful to be able to feed back the positives and kind words to the staff who support your children.

It is always beneficial, through the comments section, to hear your thoughts and views on areas of communication and support that could be improved and developed. Some parents/carers have been contacted directly to follow up responses. Where there was a common view shared by more than one reply, this will be followed through into a broader action plan for the coming year.

## Summary of questions and responses:

- 87.5% agreed that their child is making good progress at school.
- 75% agreed that they knew how their child is supported in school.
- 100% shared they were happy with the support their child is receiving.
- 87.5% feel that they have sufficient information and communication about my child's progress.
- 75% are satisfied they have been offered the opportunity to share my child's targets and individual pupil plan with their class teacher.
- 100% feel they are able to approach staff in school about any concerns or suggestions for support that they have regarding my child.
- 100% feel that any SEN issues or concerns raised have been addressed in a timely manner.
- 100% have confidence in the leadership of SEN provision and intervention within the school.

While this is encouraging, our aim is to continually and consistently improve how pupils and their parents/carers experience SEN support. This will be a priority moving forward and your thoughts and opinions contribute to this process of development.
