## OSMINGTON BAY (PGL) – INFORMATION SHEET

Important information about our forthcoming visit.

### Accommodation

The children share comfortable cabins with bunk beds. This year we have cabins sleeping 4's and 6's. They are expected to keep their cabins tidy and a competition will run throughout the week to encourage diligence and good behaviour.

The children are not allowed to make or receive phone calls, so do check their mobile phones stay at home! Should there be an emergency at home, contact Peel Common Junior School who will be in touch with Osmington Bay daily.

### Pocket Money

In line with previous residential visits, no child should have more than £10.00. This is a maximum figure and parents may wish to send their child with less. Pocket money will be given out on Monday. All pocket money should be handed in before the end of this half term please (**Thursday** 24<sup>th</sup> October).

### Valuables

Children are responsible for any valuables they bring. Apart from a watch and stud earrings, no jewellery should be worn and cameras (not phone cameras) are taken at their own risk. Electronic devices are not allowed, however, travelling games, cards, a reading book, puzzle books etc are also a good idea to occupy the children whilst travelling, just before lights out or in the event of their waking up early in the morning.



## Clothing

The children will spend the majority of their time in the open air and it is important that appropriate clothing is provided, all **clearly marked with the child's name**. Please refer to the equipment list provided. They will also need to pack party clothes for the disco evening.

## Medication

Please ensure the medical form you have already received is completed and returned to the school office **as soon as possible**. **Don't forget the NHS number - it is essential that this is included**.

Children needing medication should give it to a member of staff, on the morning of departure for them to look after and administer. Instructions/dosage for medicines should be clearly marked. For children who suffer from travel sickness, please remember pills for the return journey too. Children requiring inhalers must keep these with them at all times.

## Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November – Departure from Peel Common

Please arrive at 8.45am (normal school time) ready for departure. The children should have one large bag or suitcase containing most of their belongings, and a smaller rucksack containing items for the journey and a water bottle. No fizzy drinks, glass bottles or cans please. We will provide sweets for the journeys.

## Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November

Return to Peel Common Junior School around home time – depending on the traffic! We will keep you updated via text.

### Kit List suggestions

- Outdoor clothing **suitable for all weathers** that is comfortable and easy to move in (joggers/leggings rather than jeans please). **Lots of layers** including hats, scarves and gloves. Lots of socks and underwear
- Waterproof jacket and trousers
- Suitable footwear – trainers/walking boots are ideal with good grip. Wellies (site can be muddy in wet weather) however these cannot be worn for climbing activities. Indoor footwear for cabins are also a good idea e.g. slippers/slipper socks
- A separate Disco outfit for the final evening
- Wash kit with necessary items. The children will have ample opportunity to shower
- Towel
